Basic form

Author, A. A., Author B. B., & Author C.C. (Year). Title of article. *Title of Periodical*, volume number(issue number), pages.

Article in journal paginated by volume (APA, p. 199)

Goodnow, C. C. (2001). Pathways for self-tolerance and the treatment of autoimmune diseases. *The Lancet*, 357, 2115-2121.

Article in journal paginated by issue (APA, p. 199)

Klimosky, R., & Palmer, S. (1993). The ADA and the hiring process. *Consulting Psychology Journal*, 45(2), 10-36.

Magazine article (APA, p. 200)

Adams, J. M. (2001, May 1). Does your temperament suit your life? *Health*, 15, 108-114.

Books

Basic form (APA, p. 202)

Author, A. A. (Year of publication). *Title of book: Subtitle*. Location: Publisher.

Entire book (APA, p. 203)

Beck, C. A. J., & Sales, B. D. (2001). *Family mediation: Facts, myths, and future prospects*. Washington, DC: American Psychological Association.

Edited book (APA, p. 202)

Gibbs, J. T., & Huang, L. N. (Eds.). (1991). *Children of color*. San Francisco: Jossey-Bass.

Encyclopedia article/entry (APA, p. 203)

Borgatta, E.F. (1991). Balance theory. In *The encyclopedia of sociology* (Vol. 1, p. 224). New York: Simon & Schuster.

Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders

American Psychiatric Association. (2000). *Diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders* (4th ed.). Washington, DC: Author.

*In text: American Psychiatric Association Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders in first mention. Thereafter use the traditional form *DSM-IV-TR* in the text.
